JOB SUMMARY:

We are looking for enthusiastic and committed qualified Therapists to help us continue to deliver our outstanding therapy services for children, young people and families. Our qualified therapists are an important and valued part of the Grief Encounter Team and you will be key in providing therapeutic intervention for bereaved young people aged 4 - 25 years old, working with a caseload of 20 clients at one time. Providing one to one, group work and facilitating at our events and workshops.

As part of the clinical team within Grief Encounter you will be provided with regular Line Management and Clinical Supervision. Working within our office base, local schools and the community.

MAIN DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To provide 1-2-1 therapeutic support to children and young people age 4-25 who are experiencing grief due to a bereavement.
- To provide group therapy to our children and young people.
- To work in line with the organisation's aims and within organisational policies and procedures as outlined in the induction programme. This includes Safeguarding, Child Protection. Data security and Confidentiality.
- To provide family assessment face to face and online.
- To follow safe and effective working practices in line with Grief Encounter policies whilst working online and Face to Face.
- Engage in a minimum of 1.5 hours monthly clinical supervision with Grief Encounter supervisors. This to ensure safe working practices, maintaining accountability and duty of care within the organisation.

- A qualified counsellor/psychotherapist/creative therapist with relevant training and/or experience in bereavement and loss.

 - In-depth knowledge of the theories underpinning grief counselling.
